Key Accomplishments



In 2024–2025, iCARE4 Adoptive And Foster Families made significant strides through a focus on professional development, resource distribution, and policy collaboration. The organization delivered 25 trainings at conferences and school workshops to over 400 educators and social workers, focusing on healing-centered practices and earning high praise for both the expertise and the practical value to participants' work with students. iCARE also distributed 1,200 bilingual Connection Kits™ to more than 1,000 schools, embedding regulation tools and inclusive language to help create emotionally safe spaces for students. Through legislative roundtables and workgroups, iCARE partnered with key organizations like West40 and C.A.S.E. to advance trauma-responsive mental health training for schools. These collaborations in training, resource distribution, and advocacy ultimately impacted over 600,000 students across the state.

Connected We Thrive[™] Professional Development Series

- Delivered 25 in-person and conference trainings to over 400 educators, social workers, and administrators, focusing on healing-centered practices for students with complex family stories
- Participant feedback showed an average rating of 3.9 out of 4 for presenter skill, knowledge, and usefulness.
- Sessions increased understanding, strengthened professional practice, and gave attendees
 practical strategies they could use immediately.

Connected We Thrive[™] Professional Development Series

- Distributed 1,200 free bilingual Connection Kits[™] to over 1,000 schools across multiple
 Illinois districts.
- Kits embedded regulation tools and inclusive language into classrooms, accompanied by interactive walk-throughs aligned with MTSS and SEL frameworks.
- Helped educators create regulation-ready, emotionally safe spaces that support student engagement and learning.

Systems and Policy Collaboration

- Hosted legislative roundtables and workgroups with leaders in education, mental health, and child welfare.
- Partnered with West40, C.A.S.E., DCFS, and other key organizations to advance adoptioncompetent, trauma-responsive mental health training for schools.
- Combined reach of training, resource distribution, and advocacy impacted over 600,000 students statewide.

In 2025–2026, iCARE will take bold steps to ensure every child impacted by adoption, foster care, or kinship care has the understanding and support they deserve.
